Service summary

Community Pastimes Hartlepool

Community Pastimes runs a programme of events in Hartlepool Monday to Friday 10am - 1pm or 2.15pm - 5pm to meet the needs and offer social stimulation to people living with dementia or a memory impairment.

The service provides group activities in various locations in Hartlepool to promote social inclusion, independence and reduce the risk of social isolation. Some of the venues visited include The Heugh Battery, Historic Quay, ladies who Lunch clubs, Ten pin bowling, men's groups etc.

Community pastimes also offer a 1:1 service on a private basis where clients can be supported to visit family or friends, attend events and activities of their choosing and be supported with shopping task or enjoy a sitting service within their own home where staff will bring activities to them to offer stimulation and engagement.

If the client is assessed as being entitled to local authority financial support, then the service can be paid for via this method after assessments via Local authority. Alternatively, the service can be purchased privately.
